



## The Fort Worth Thunderbirds Radio Control Association, Inc.



### **Membership Application and Renewal Form**

- Your membership is valid from January 1 to December 31 each year.
- A current Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) membership card is required to fly at the flying site. Only a current AMA membership card may be placed in the frequency board.
- All members except honorary and associate are eligible to vote in club business.
- Family membership dues are \$10.00 higher than an individual. (Note: No partial payments accepted)
- Name badges are available for \$10.30 each. Includes name and AMA number.

### **Individual Member**

- Is a single membership which has all rights and privileges. The annual dues are \$65.00 per calendar year. New members joining after July 1 will pay a minimum \$32.50 for the remainder of the year.

### **Family Member(s)**

- Is a family membership which has all rights and privileges. Limited to two (2) votes per membership. Consists of a primary member, spouse and children. A child is defined to be 18 years of age or younger. All associated family members must reside in the same household as the primary member. The annual dues are \$75.00 per calendar year. New members joining after July 1 will pay a minimum \$37.50 for the remainder of the year. In addition, only a primary member is allowed to hold an association officer position.

### **Associate Member**

- An associate membership has no voting rights, and in order to be considered for an associate membership the primary applicant's residence must be greater than 50 miles from the flying site at Benbrook Lake. The annual dues are \$32.50 per calendar year. There is no price break for applying after July 1.

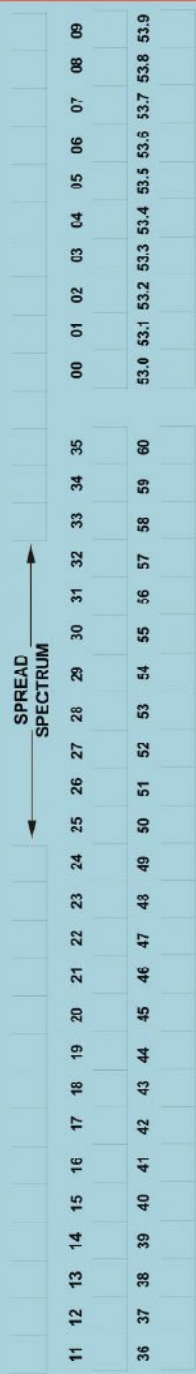

ALL AMA, CORPS OF ENGINEERS, AND THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO EVERYONE FLYING AT THIS FIELD

1. Neither the Thunderbirds nor the Corps of Engineers is responsible for accident or injury.
2. Reserve a frequency by placing your AMA card in the frequency board.
3. Remove card (except for spread spectrum) after your transmitter is turned off to open the frequency.
4. Per AMA rules, do not fly over unprotected persons.
5. Pilots shall stand in the station nearest the downwind end of the runway. In case of a crosswind pilots shall work together to determine the station to use.
5. All engines are required to have a muffler.
7. Aircraft must follow the takeoff and landing pattern in effect.
8. Landing aircraft have the right-of-way over aircraft taking off.
9. Running aircraft shall not be left unattended.
10. No more than 5 pilots are permitted to fly in each designated area at one time.
11. "Zones" shown at right must be observed.
